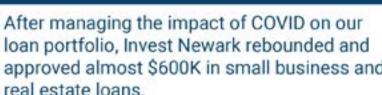

Invest Newark's Business Development services provide support for Newark's diverse and growing business community. Specifically, we connect entrepreneurs to state and local resources; offer trainings to entrepreneurs to help them achieve success; increase their exposure through promotional events and platforms; and fund entrepreneurs via small business loans and grants.

loan portfolio, Invest Newark rebounded and approved almost \$600K in small business and real estate loans.

Invest Newark began tracking this data in 2022. \$13.2MM was expended by Invest Newark and on behalf of related entities. Of that total 63% or \$8.3MM was spent with MWBE firms.





## Newark **Land Bank**

In 2022 as in 2021, the Newark Land Bank, under the management of Invest Newark provided homeownership opportunities for Newark residents. In doing so we engaged local MWBE firms, supported the local economy, helped create jobs and increased the real estate value in Newark neighborhoods. 71 or 83% of the city properties transferred from the first tranche have been put back into productive use or have firm plans. In October 2022, the Municipal Council approved the transfer of a second tranche of 85 properties.

Newark Fiber is a public private partnership that provides high-speed, low-cost broadband access for municipal operations, private businesses, and residents. Ensuring residents and businesses have the connectivity necessary to grow their businesses, learn online, and access telemedicine is an economic imperative. Invest Newark, in partnership with the City of Newark and GigXero is proud to continue investing in Newark Fiber's expansion closing the digital divide.
