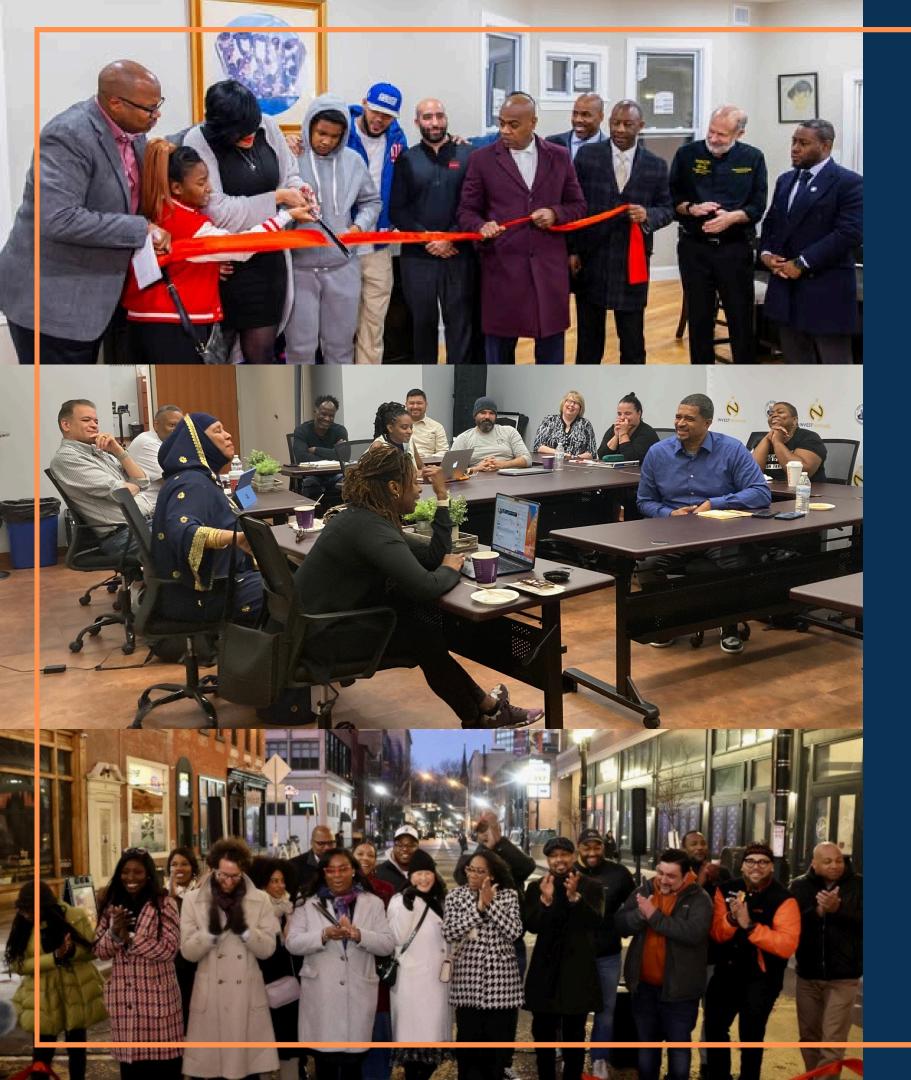

\$3.6M Total Grants Awarded Invest Newark's Business Development services provide support for Newark's diverse and growing business community.

Specifically, we connect entrepreneurs to state and local resources, offer training to help them achieve success, increase their exposure through promotional events and platforms, and fund entrepreneurs via small business loans and grants.

The City of Newark and Invest Newark awarded \$3.6 million in funding for fifteen retail businesses as part of the Retail Reactivation Initiative to increase the number of amenities in Newark's Arts & Education District.



Newark Land Bank

The Newark Land Bank, an entity of Invest Newark, created homeownership opportunities for Newark residents. In doing so, we engaged local MWBE firms, supported the local economy, helped create jobs, and increased the real estate value in Newark neighborhoods. The city has transferred 169 properties to the Newark Land Bank since 2021 of which 68 have been developed or sold.

Newark Restaurant Week

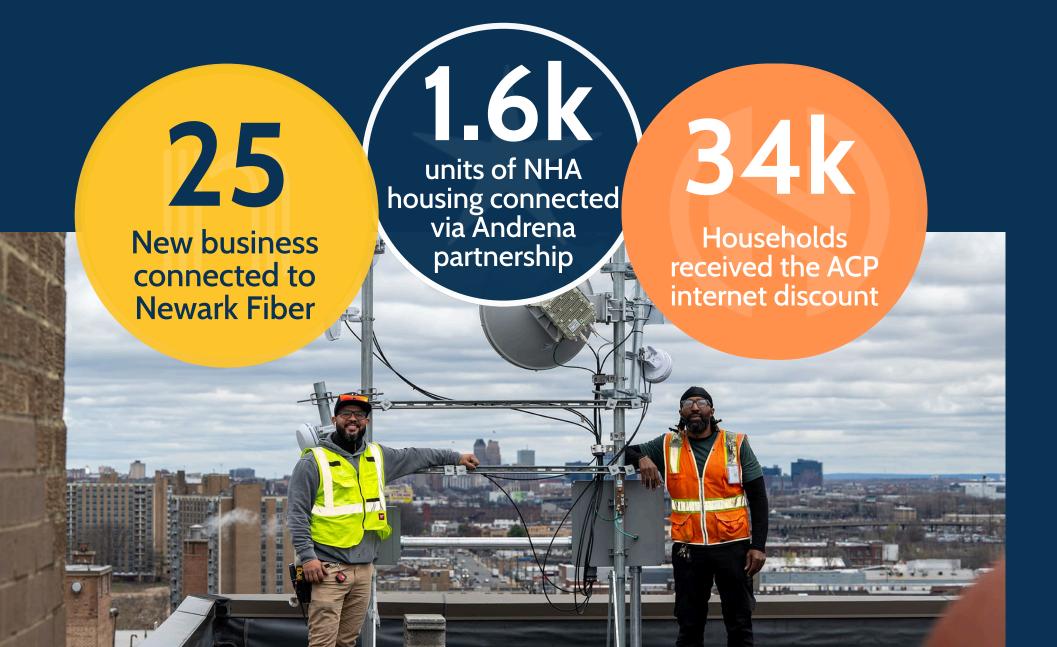
For the 4th year in a row, Invest Newark sponsored Newark Restaurant Week. Over 60 local restaurants experienced increased patronage and garnered statewide attention.
